

IN A CAVE



- Read 1 Kings 19.
- Are you familiar with the broom tree? If so, is there any significance in Elijah choosing to stop there?
- How was Elijah feeling in verse 10? Has there ever been a time you felt just as Elijah did? Have you ever poured your heart and soul into something or someone and the result was failure or perceived as failure?
- Re-read verses 11-12. What do you notice? Do you wait expectantly to hear/see the Lord in big, obvious ways? Do you overlook Him in the “gentle whisper”?
- Read verse 13. Why do you think God asked Elijah the same question twice?

APPLICATION

There is no doubt Elijah was a faithful and passionate servant of the Lord. The Israelites completely turned their back on God. This left Elijah feeling alone, isolated, and depressed. He had thought his ministry had ended and failed. Yet God still had work for him to do. Is there a cave that you are hiding in? How can you listen for the “gentle whisper”? What is God whispering to you?
