Construction

Team members will help with an assortment of projects. The projects could be as simple as painting a house to building a home. We will work alongside the locals, deferring to their knowledge of available resources. All skill levels are welcome.



Medical

Team members will serve in clinics in a variety of ways from calming and praying with patients to taking vital statistics to medical exams. Some basic medical training may be taught in pre-trip meetings.
