QUESTIONS TO CONSIDER:

- 1. What was your takeaway from the message and why? Was there anything that surprised you?
- 2. It was said this weekend that, "Satan often tries to get you to take ownership of your diagnosis. What did that mean? Why is it important to remember that your identity is not your diagnosis?
- Read Luke 4:16-21. The reason Jesus came was to help and heal us. He ministered in people's physical, mental, biological, and spiritual buckets. What are some stories in the Bible that reveal this truth? (Physical, John 8:1-11; Mental, Luke 8:35; Biological, Mark 5:25- 24; Spiritual, Luke 5:17-39)

Why should knowing this increase our faith? What hope does it give those in your life struggling in these areas? What light does this shed on how you can improve your ministry to struggling people?

- 4. Read **Luke 12:6-7**. Have you ever been guilty of withholding the little things in your life from God? Why do we do this? What is the trap that is set when we try to manage the little things ourselves?
- 5. Of the 5 truths about God which one do you struggle to believe? Why?
 - GOD IS NOT SURPRISED BY YOUR STRUGGLES
 - GOD IS NOT SURPRISED BY OUR SIN
 - NOTHING IS TOO SMALL FOR GOD
 - GOD HAS THE POWER TO RESTORE THAT WHICH IS RUINED
 - IT'S NEVER TOO LATE
